



**DR. MITCHELL DOUGLASS**, Child Psychiatrist and Medical Director of Marillac, University of Kansas Health System



A Kansas City native, Dr. Mitchell M. Douglass, MD graduated from the University of Rochester in upstate NY in 2004 knowing he wanted to treat all aspects of children's health.

Dr. Douglass then completed the University of Kentucky Triple Board program in 2009, becoming board eligible in pediatrics, adult psychiatry, and child psychiatry.

In 2015 Dr. Douglass joined the Department of Psychiatry as medical director of Marillac, the inpatient child psychiatry hospital for the University of Kansas Health System. Over the past five years Marillac has increased its bed capacity, developed Insights, a specialized suicide prevention unit.
